The Natursutten soother is made from soft, natural, sustainable rubber and therefore it contains no toxic chemicals. It might look a little bit funny but this innovative design is made out of one piece and because of this there are no tiny gaps, joins and cracks for nasty bacteria or yucky residue to hide in (Have you

looked at your babies dummy lately, and I mean closely?.... Exactly!) . The one-piece design also lowers the choking hazard, standard dummies are at risk for coming apart and as a result your baby could choke on the mouthpiece.

At first I had my doubts about the shape of this dummy, the round shield is a larger than normal and seemed big for such a little face. But once I read up on the Natursutten dummy a bit more I started to appreciate this design a lot. The larger shield prevents baby from bending the rubber and fitting it in his/her mouth. It also nearly touches the babies nose and in doing so it mimics the feeling of the mothers breast, making this is a great dummy for breastfed babies. I think this is why my daughter loves this dummy a lot and we have not used her old dummies since. She is happy with the shape and I'm happy knowing it is safe and natural, the perfect combination.
